EXTRA INFORMATION

No Stallions to be ridden on the Saturday.

On Sunday stallions only to be ridden by adults over the age of eighteen.

DEFINITION OF A LOCAL RIDER: A person living in the Shire of Toodyay or a member of either the Adult Riding Club or the Pony Club.

BREED EVENTS: The horse breeding year dates from the 1st August in each year. Stallions are not allowed on the ground without approved head gear and must be visibly entire.

DISEASED EXHIBITS: Should the committee have any reason to suspect that any exhibit is suspect of being diseased the Ring Mistress may insist that the exhibit is removed from the show-grounds immediately.

DANGEROUS EXHIBITS: Should any exhibit display dangerous or objectionable behaviour in the show ring or in the horse area of the show grounds the exhibit will be ordered to be removed from the grounds.

INTOXICATED EXHIBITORS: Should any exhibitor display intoxicated behaviour they will be ordered to remove themselves from the show ring immediately.

The committee reserves the right to refuse or accept conditionally any entry without assigning any reasons.

The Ring committee has made every endeavour to include a large and varied selection of events. The timetable has been carefully worked out in an attempt to avoid clashes. However, in the event that this does occur, you will be required to choose which event you wish to compete in. In order to run on time we need your total co-operation, therefore **COMPETITORS NOT ON TIME** for their chosen events will be excluded from the ring. Rings will not be held up to wait for competitors!

DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS

PARKING - Parking in relation to Ring Events is only allowed in the specified contained area for those vehicles directly involved in floating horses.

IF YARD IS CLEANED AND CHECKED BY SHOW OFFICIAL

Limited yards will be available on grounds - first booked first served till all full.

**ARMBANDS FOR HACKING are \$5 payable with entries -
this will be refunded to you when you return your armband.**

One free entry into show grounds is granted per person per horse.

REFUNDS: Non participation in an event will NOT warrant a refund of entry fees. Entry fees will only be refunded minus a \$10 admin fee if the request is accompanied by a Vet Certificate or a Doctors Certificate dated within 7 days prior to the show.

JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL IN ALL CASES:

Judges are NOT to be approached under any circumstances by any competitor or spectator. Classes will NOT be held up for late arrivals except at the discretion of the Judge. Classes may be split or combined at the discretion of the Judge. All Judges decisions ARE FINAL.

Conditions of Entry

**PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS & BY-LAWS
BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR ENTRIES**

Regulations and by-laws for the annual Toodyay show - subject to any alteration that the committee may deem advisable, may be inspected prior to the first day of the show at the Secretary's Office on the grounds.

These regulations and by-laws are to govern the fixture, together with the uniform by-laws of the Royal Agricultural Society Act 1926.

•The committee reserve the right to refuse, cancel or accept conditionally any entry without being require to give any explanation of being liable for any compensation.

•**The owner or exhibitor of any exhibit, disapproved of as an exhibit by the committee, must immediately on notice that effect, remove such exhibit from the grounds.**

•Dogs are not permitted in the grounds except where entered as exhibits, under the control of a police officer or by permission from the society.

•The committee reserves the power to reject or remove or have removed any exhibitor, servant or attendant, or any visitor from the Show whose conduct or actions are deemed by the committee to be out of order or in contravention of the Society's rules, regulations or by-laws without being required to give any explanation or being liable for compensation.

•The decision of the committee on all points shall be final and without recourse.

•Any exhibitor giving a wrong description of their exhibit with the intention of deceiving or defrauding the Society shall be disqualified from exhibiting at any future show and the particulars of the case shall be recorded in the proceedings of the Society.

SOCIETY'S LIABILITES: The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibitor and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident.

PROTESTS: Must be lodged within one hour after the event with a deposit of \$20 to the Chief Ring Mistress. The deposit shall be forfeited to the Society if the protest on due consideration be deemed unfounded or frivolous. Any prize money or awards which may be withheld in consequent of any valid protestors shall be forfeited to the Society. Should any exhibit, having gained a prize, be disqualified (either by protest or for any other reason) the next on the list does not necessarily or automatically obtain such prize. The committee, with or without advice of the judge, shall decide the question.
