CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - *please read carefully*

This event is to be conducted under the current rules and by-laws of Equestrian Australia as amended.

In addition this event will be conducted under the current specific Equestrian Australia Show Horse Rules as amended.

NEWCOMERS:

To be eligible horses/ponies must have competed in at least one official Show Horse, Show Hunter fixture (in their appropriate class) within the qualifying period. If no place is awarded, attendance must be verified, either by the Judge or club official, by signing the Newcomer card. Licence cards will be issued by the office and **MUST** be returned with entries.

Please Note: Competing in ridden breed classes prior to the qualifying period will render a horse/pony ineligible to compete as an EWA Newcomer.

- ◆ Horses/ponies are not eligible to enter if they have competed outside the Qualifying period.
 - ◆ Horse/pony must be domiciled in WA for a total minimum period of three months during the twelve months immediately preceding the day of the show.
 - ◆ Any horse or pony, having competed interstate during this period, will be required to provide proof of eligibility. Horses arriving from interstate or internationally must provide details of qualifying performances to the Show Horse Coordinator, prior to the Newcomer licence being issued.
 - ◆ Horses/ponies must compete in a snaffle bit.
 - ◆ Horses/ponies must have a current EWA registration at the time of qualifying.
 - ◆ Owners and Riders must be current EWA financial members at the time of qualifying.
 - ◆ Horses/ponies must have a current EWA Height Certificate.
 - ◆ Horses/Ponies must have a current Newcomer license. **Card must be returned at time of entering by email to Show Horse Coordinator, Rhiannon Bealey** at rhiannon.bealey@equestrianwa.org.au

- **Show Ponies 12h & under (must be ridden by a child 14 yrs and under), as per National EA Rules**
 - Show Pony over 12 hands up to and inc 14 hands ridden by a rider any age.
 - Show Galloway over 14hands up to and inc 15 hands ridden by a rider any age.
 - Show Hack over 15 hands ridden by a rider any age.

- **Show Hunter Ponies 12h & under (must be ridden by a child 14yrs and under), as per National EA Rules**

 - Show Hunter Hack over 15 hands ridden by a rider any age.

QUALIFYING PERIOD FOR 2017 NEWCOMERS IS FROM CLOSE OF ENTRIES 2016 (13TH May 2016) until close of entries 2017 (12TH MAY 2017).

ENTRIES CLOSE FOR THE 2017 NEWCOMERS EVENT ON THE 12TH MAY 2017

INTERMEDIATE:

Horse/pony is **not** to have been awarded Champion or Reserve Champion at any Show that has been judged by an International or Eastern States Judge. In addition the horse/pony is **not** to have been awarded 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any hack or hunter class at any Royal Show, Winner or Runner-up at EWA HOTY, EWA Intermediate HOTY or SHC Horse of the Year.

An Intermediate horse/pony is an intermediate horse/pony on the day of Competition i.e. if a horse/pony is awarded a champion or reserve champion between the close of entries and the date of event they will become ineligible to compete as an Intermediate. Under these circumstances a refund can be applied for.

- **Show Ponies 12h & under (must be ridden by a child 14 yrs and under), as per National EA Rules**
- Show Pony over 12 hands up to and inc 14 hands ridden by a rider any age.
- Show Galloway over 14 hands up to and inc 15 hands ridden by a rider any age.
- Show Hack over 15 hands ridden by a rider any age.

- **Show Hunter Ponies 12h & under (must be ridden by a child 14yrs and under), as per National EA Rules**
- Show Hunter Pony over 12 hands up to and inc 14 hands ridden by a rider any age
- Show Hunter Galloway over 14 hands up to and inc 15 hands rider any age
- Show Hunter Hack over 15 hands ridden by a rider any age

ENTRIES CLOSE FOR THE 2017 INTERMEDIATE HORSE OF THE YEAR ON THE 12TH MAY 2017

INTERMEDIATE CLASSES WILL COMMENCE AT THE COMPLETION OF NEWCOMER CLASSES.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - *please read carefully*

This event is to be conducted under the current rules and by-laws of Equestrian Australia as amended.

- **In addition this event will be conducted under the current specific Equestrian Australia Show Horse Rules as amended.**

The onus is on the competitor to have full knowledge of the above rules. Rules can be downloaded from www.equestrian.org.au

- The organizers of EWA Show horse reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any events they deem necessary on the day.
- Horses and Ponies original current EWA height certificate must be available on the day. No photo image will be accepted.
- Horses and Ponies must be EWA registered and hold a current EWA show horse card which must be available on the day. No photo image will be accepted.
- Riders must have current EWA membership and membership card must be available on the day. No photo image will be accepted.
- Horse/pony may only compete as a show horse or show hunter.
- Riders must wear a current approved safety helmet and riding boots while mounted on any horse or pony at all times. Please refer to the EWA website for the new approved headwear. <http://www.equestrian.org.au/content/current-approved-safety-standards-helmets>
- Rider's age will be as of the 1st January 2017.
- The Judges decision is final. Judges are not to be approached under ANY circumstances.
- Protests must be made in writing and be referred to the ground jury, a deposit of \$50.00 must be made with the lodgement of the protest and this will not be refundable, if the protest is not upheld.
- Show Ponies and Show Hunter Ponies not exceeding 12 hands must be ridden by a child rider 14 yrs of age and under.
- Show Ponies and Show Hunter Ponies over 12 hands can be ridden by a rider of any age unless otherwise specified on the program.
- BYO Alcohol is not Permitted on the Grounds
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- Failure to abide by the rules may lead to disqualification and loss of prizes.
- Refunds will only be given with a veterinary or medical certificate provided to the EA Show Horse coordinator within 7 days of the competition, less \$20.00 administration fee.
- Random swabbing will take place.

- If entering both Newcomers and Intermediate Classes, show horse levy and ground fee is only payable once per horse per day.

FALL OF HORSE AND/OR RIDER

If in the lineup, during a workout, or on the circle there is a fall of horse and/or rider it will entail elimination from that class. If a horse leaves the workout area, other than at the direction of a judge or official, it will entail elimination from that class. The Judge has the power to eliminate a horse or rider if it is deemed by the judge to be erratic and unruly. In the event of a fall by horse or competitor, it will be the decision of the Judge or Ground Jury, or if there is no Ground Jury, a representative of the organising committee, (informed if necessary by a doctor or medical officer in the case of a rider or a vet or horse welfare officer in the case of a horse), as to whether the rider or horse can continue to compete. Riders must be mounted on entering and leaving the arena or penalty of elimination.
