EWA CLASSES: Are ridden under EA Eventing rules and are for EA members only. Rules can be found at http://www.wa.equestrian.org.au Rider must check that their EWA membership is current and correct for the level they are competing at.

PCAWA CLASSES: Are ridden under PCAWA Rules and are for PCAWA members only. Pony Club uniform must be worn.

Reminders:- Medical arm bands and PC cards need to be sighted at registration. Rider bib/numbers are required.

There are NO OPEN classes in this event. PCAWA Annual Insurance Members cannot enter this event.

HELPERS: All competitors must nominate a helper over 16 years of age. Riders must include helper's mobile number. A standard helper duty time is 4 hours per horse. Limited self- help is available. Self help is **not** available to riders of more than one horse. **If your allocated helper does not turn up to your duty, you will face immediate elimination.**

WITHDRAWALS: The Secretary must be notified of withdrawals by 4pm of the day prior to the commencement of the event. Withdrawals prior to the Event closing on KTrials will receive a full refund less a 10% admin fee. Refund of entries after close will be in accordance with EA National Eventing Rules effective January 2015, however, a proportion of fees may be refunded if: (a) sufficient notice of withdrawal is given with a vet or doctors certificate and (b) a helper is provided. Please note you are obliged to notify the Organising Committee (OC) of your intent to withdraw. It is requested that you do so as soon as possible.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT: The Organisers or this event: Reserve the right: + to cancel any class or event + to divide any class + to transfer competitors between sections of a class + to alter the advertised times and to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.

DRESSAGE TESTS: 60m x 20m for all dressage tests. Tests found at http://www.wa.equestrian.org.au/eventing/eventing-dressage-tests

SHOW JUMPING: Some show jumping will be conducted on Saturday,. Some classes will be required to show jump before the cross country.

PRIZES/PRIZE MONEY: As recommended by EA. Rugs and trophies subject to sponsors.

STABLES: There are 55 indoor stables available plus cattle yards on the southern side of the grounds near the dam. Please note that the stables are left clean and tidy and in the condition prior to use. Stables or yards can be booked for the entire weekend at a cost of \$50 (cash only) which includes a \$30 bond to be returned at the end of the weekend. To avoid disappointment bookings are essential. For bookings please contact stable hire for GH&PC members is free but booking is essential.

GO PRO/HELMET CAMERA USE: Use of a fitted camera is at the discretion of the Technical delegates and MUST have approval prior to the start of the cross country phase. Riders need to see the Tech Delegates on **Saturday** to have their camera approved. Helmet camera or Go Pro are **not** permitted for use by PCAWA riders.

ACCOMMODATION: Camping is free of charge at the Gidgegannup Equestrian Centre. Limited showers available.

RIDERS PLEASE NOTE: Ambulance, Veterinary and Farrier costs incurred at this event are the responsibility of the rider.

REFRESHMENTS: Full canteen from Saturday 10.00am and Sunday 7.30am.

HAY AND STRAW: No hay, straw or rubbish to be left on the grounds or in the stables. Please, please, please take it away with you!

MANURE: Manure **must be** bagged and taken home or placed at manure bag collection points around the grounds otherwise camping overnight may not be allowed in the future by the City of Swan. **PLEASE DO NOT PUT MANURE AROUND TREES OR IN THE BUSH AREAS.**
