DANGEROUS & DISEASED EXHIBITS. Should the council have any reason to suspect that any exhibit is dangerous or objectionable, it may have same removed from or refused admission to the grounds The Committee reserves the right to refuse or accept conditionally any entry without assigning any reasons.

PROGRAMME. The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend this program in any way it sees fit without giving prior warning.
