#### **DESCRIPTION OF EVENTS**

**OPTIMUM TIME:** The rider endeavours to ride the course according to how the judge has measured the course and speed it should be ridden at. The rider closest to the time with the least amount of faults is the winner.

**AM7:** A competitor with a clear round rides a jump off course before leaving the arena. The competitor has 45 seconds only to go through the starting flags after the judge sounds the bell for the jump off. The AM7 jump off may include 2 new obstacles. The jump off course can be found on the map of the course which is displayed at the entrance gate

**OTT:** This class is for OTT thoroughbreds and Standardbreds. This class will be included within the Optimum Time of every height. If you nominate to do optimum time in any height and own an OTT, you will automatically go into this class. Rosettes will be awarded  $1^{st}-6^{th}$  as well as points which will be tallied and the rider with the most points at the end of the day will win the woollen rug for best performed OTT.

#### PINJARRA HORSE AND PONY CLUB SHOW JUMP EVENT INFORMATION

#### **RING 1 TRAINING ROUNDS:**

Pre Entry and Entry on the day \$5 per training round

- Approved helmets, boots and long sleeves are mandatory
- Riders can wear pony club uniform and/or hacking jacket, clothing must be long sleeved if other options are not available
- PCAWA gear check rules will be enforced
- Once on course, if you have 3 refusals at one jump, you must move onto the next jump

#### **RING 2 COMPETITIVE ROUNDS**

PCAWA jumping rules apply The judge's decision is final Pre entry only at \$10 per class No entries on the day

- Horse and rider combinations can enter in ring 1 and/or ring 2 but ring 2 must take precedence, as it is in draw order
- PLEASE NOTE RIDERS ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO DO 3 CONSECUTIVE HEIGHTS
- Riders are to wear hacking jackets or pony club formal uniform with approved helmets and boots, as PCAWA gear check rules will be enforced
- Classes will be broken into 3 groups: Rider 13 yrs and under, Rider 14 yrs and over and rider over 25 yrs. Ribbons awarded up to 6<sup>th</sup> place and 1<sup>st</sup> place getters will receive a prize
- Optimum Time will be broken into 4 groups: Rider 13 yrs and under, Rider 14 yrs and over,
   Rider over 25 yrs and OTT.
- Ribbons and prizes can be collected from the club room after announced

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Rings will be opened half an hour before start time

Courses will be open for walking after each height change

PCAWA gear checking rules apply for this event

Horse and rider combinations can enter maximum 4 rounds over both rings on the day

Ground fee is per horse excluding Pinjarra horse and pony club members

Horse and rider combinations can enter a competitive class twice, but the second round will be non competitive

Each rider must nominate a helper over the age of 17yrs. One horse – One helper – if the same helper is nominated for more than 1 rider they will get more than one job. **Very limited self help is available and only in consultation with the event organiser by email or phone call and will be either set up or marshal/gear checker.** No self help is available for riders with 2 horses competing.

#### **PARKING**

Parking is limited at our grounds and floats can only enter the grounds via Love Grove Street. Parking within the grounds is now prohibited, but there are yards available to competitors on a first come first serve basis. Parking on the gravel area adjacent to the cricket oval will only be used if the parking space off Love Grove Street becomes full. Cars without floats are asked to park on the gravel area or on Love Grove Street.

Please leave the grounds as found, spread you horses poo around trees and take all hay home with you. No riders under the age of 18 to be left on grounds without a parent/guardian
