## **BIO-SECURITY**

Alcoa is a working farm. If your float is stored where it can be contaminated by farm animals (or is used to transport farm animals) please ensure it is washed down. If you cannot wash it down, please advise so we can arrange for a fire pump to be available prior to your arrival.

#### HELPERS

All competitors must nominate a helper OR pay a \$80.00 helper fee. For multiple rides the 3rd, 4th and 5th horse shall attract an additional \$30 per horse. Jobs will be allocated on a per horse basis. Helpers MUST be over 16 years of age and physically able. If for some reason your helper has physical restrictions you must inform the entry secretary prior to entering. **Self Help (by arrangement ONLY, you must contact entry secretary prior to entering to confirm)** 

Limited Self Help is available as XCJJ only (as suited to your riding times) or Busy Bee/Set-up Fri/Pack-up Mon. Self help **not available for** riders with multiple rides.

#### Busy Bee – Saturday 13th Sept 9.00am – 12noon

Busy Bee attendance will count as a helper duty and self helpers are encouraged to attend. Busy Bee attendance is also encouraged for **all riders**, **over and above their helper duty** – come down and enjoy a morning's work and a sausage sizzle for lunch. All help is much appreciated.

Paid Officials will not be accepted as helpers. These are special arrangements and must be discussed with Entry Secretary prior to entering the event.

**WITHDRAWALS and CHANGES** The Secretary should be advised as soon as possible. Full refund of entry <u>prior</u> to closing date (less 5% online entry cost). Refunds after the close of entries shall be considered as per the Eventing Rules 2014. Riders can make their own changes prior to closing date. For riders of multiple horses, where selected grades/horses may change, it is recommended you do not pay until nearer the closing date to save administration costs in fees due.

#### LATE ENTRIES

A \$50 late fee per horse will apply after closing date if entry is accepted. Contact Entry Secretary.

#### STABLES / YARDS

<u>No</u> yards available. You may build your own yards (no rope or electrical tape/wire). Horses must be supervised overnight.

#### ACCOMMODATION

Camping free of charge. No power provided. Limited facilities available, however, Fairbridge Village kindly offers use of shower block. Houses at Fairbridge must be booked through Fairbridge Village (ph. 9531 1177). Hotel accommodation is available in Waroona, Yarloop and Pinjarra. Pinjarra Caravan Park offer cabins (ph. 9531 1374). Please be aware that the rider is responsible for the care of their horse while on the grounds. **Yarded horses must be supervised overnight**.
