If dogs are brought to the event the competitor will be refused entry and asked to leave, and all entries eliminated.

Cross Country Course

The Course is relatively flat terrain with mixed sandy soils and irrigated pasture & includes both permanent and transportable type fences. There are now *two water complexes* and good open grassed country for galloping. The Ev65, EvA80 & EvA95 courses are very encouraging for young or inexperienced horse and rider combinations.

This Event is run under Equestrian Australia National Eventing Rules 2019. It is the responsibility of riders to know these Rules. Riders must be a member of EA.

ENTRIES

All riders please note:

All riders intending to compete at Capel Event will need to renew their 2019 Equestrian WA membership prior to the event. All membership numbers will be checked and if not current, fully paid & with the appropriate competition licence in place you will be unable to compete.

A Ktrials entry is not fully valid and will not hold you a position until your entry is paid for in full.

Class sizes are limited and will be closed when full. Entries are to be made only via the Ktrials online system. A \$50 late fee may apply if late entry or class changes accepted

HELPERS

Self-help is available to riders with one horse ONLY. Self-help is NOT available to riders of more than one horse, unless completed prior to the event or if two horses are in the 65 and 80 classes. **Self-helpers will be allocated to XCJJ team or pre-event set-up.** Competitors may attend a Busy Bee prior to the event or assist with set up, course flagging etc. depending on requirements, helper spots for these jobs are limited.

Helpers should be prepared for up to a 4 hour helper duty either Sat or Sun. Special requests will be filled if the Duty is available, please make a note on Entry. XCJJ get maximum flexibility to work around ride times. Other duties the time is fixed.

Helpers of Riders with multiple horses will get an extended duty of help. Helpers selecting "As Arranged" must enter the arranged duty in Comment box. Paid database helpers must be entered on Ktrials with a "DB" helper name and phone number.

The organising committee must be notified of a change of helper, experience is required to do certain jobs

PROVISIONAL TIMETABLE

Saturday – Dressage will commence on Saturday at 8:00am & some of classes Show Jumping.

Sunday – Cross Country & Show Jumping will commence at 8.00am.

STARTING TIMES (and Helper Duties) will be available on the Ktrials website approximately five days before event. Check for updates as time and duty changes can occur due to withdrawals.

WITHDRAWALS must be made by the competitor via the online entry system up to the closing date. Withdrawals after the closing date will be in accordance with EA National Eventing Rules effective January 2019. All withdrawals after the closing date must be emailed and substantiated to the event secretary capelhpcevents@gmail.com Any refunds will be at the discretion of the organising committee. A partial refund will be given depending on the amount of notice given and whether the helper duty is completed.
