CROSS COUNTRY: The course includes mostly permanent and some portable type fences. There is a water complex, the courses are very encouraging. Course designer Chris Edwards, has again been commissioned to continue work on the course.

ENTRY INFORMATION: Entry via Ktrials at www.ktrials.com.au. This event is being run by Dryandra Regional Equestrian Association, an EWA Affiliated club. You **MUST be a direct current member of EA** to enter this event – there is no day insurance and membership of an EA affiliated club (including DREA) does NOT allow entry. Entry is not fully valid and will not hold your position until your entry is paid in full via Ktrials. Entries not paid by 9pm, 10th June will be deemed invalid and deleted from the entry list. Late entries, if accepted after closing date, will incur a \$50 fee per horse.

Helmets

• It is the Rider's Responsibility or in the case of a Junior Rider the parent/guardian to ensure the Rider wears a helmet to the approved standard.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

EMERGENCY CONTACT : When entering on Ktrials, please enter an **EMERGENCY CONTACT PERSON & MOBILE NUMBER** who will be in attendance at the event with you as per EA RULES.

WITHDRAWALS: Up until 10th June close of entries, withdrawals are to be made by the competitor via Ktrials will receive a full refund. Withdrawals after close of entries, please notify the Event Secretary brooklands@bordernet.com.au of all withdrawals as soon as possible. Refund of entries will be as per EA refund policy, entry fees for scratching received after close are not refunded. However a proportion of fees MAY be refunded if: (a) sufficient notice of withdrawal is given, (b) a helper is provided. Please note you are obliged to notify the organising committee of your intent to withdraw. It is requested that you do so as soon as possible.

CANCELLATION: In the event that the organizing committee has to cancel the event close to the date, once significant expenditure has been incurred, refunds will not necessarily be given. The Organizing Committee will do their best to return as much as possible from entry fees remaining after expenses.

HELPERS

It is a condition of entry that all riders must supply a helper over the age of 16 yrs. All XCJJ must be over 18. A standard helper duty time is four hours per rider, riders with multiple rides may be given an extended duty. By entering this event you agree to this condition. Limited self help available (**MUST CONTACT EVENT SECRETARY PRIOR TO ENTRY**) with \$50 bond – **self helpers will be allocated to XCJJ team. Self help is NOT available to riders with more than one horse.**
