

The Results are in!

Congratulations to everyone who competed at the 2022 EWA and Saddles Plus Interschool Championships in April.

We have decided to publish the results ahead of the Awards Night this year so that everyone can understand how they are determined.

Under the Interschool National Rules, a team must comprise a minimum of three competitors either in the discipline or school team. In order to determine the Primary team awards, in some cases only two competitor scores have been taken into account. This method of calculating the scoring is consistent with the way Nominate Scoreboard populates and totals the scores, and is used Nationally.

The Highest Placed Age Groups and Individual Rider Awards have been calculated based respectively on the competitor's individual highest points.

For the Sport Discipline Awards (Jumping, Dressage, Combined Training and Show Horse) the top two scores (primary) or three scores (Secondary) of competitors who did that discipline have been combined to determine the Champion and Reserve Champion school or team.

The Overall Composite Primary Team awards and Secondary School awards have been calculated based on the top three scoring competitors from each Team or School.

The Off the Track Discipline Awards have been calculated based on the highest points achieved in each discipline. The Overall High Point Award is calculated on the points gained across all disciplines.

Only two Breed Societies have provided Awards this year. These are the Riding Pony Stud Book Society and the Welsh Pony and Cob Society.
