EWA Jumping Horse of the Year Leaderboard

AIM

It is envisaged that the series will act as a beneficial preparation for both horses and riders who are aiming to compete in the World Cups, Perth Royal and Patrons Cup at the end of the year by encouraging horses to comfortably move from 1.30m to 1.45m+ over a pre-arranged time frame.

OBJECTIVE

To administer, along with jump clubs, up to 10 rounds of the series to be run between March and November each calendar year

EVENT GUIDELINES

- An annual series of shows hosting Horse of the Year Series events will run throughout the calendar year in WA; set by EWAJC.
- Expressions of interest to become a host club of the Horse of the Year Series should be directed to the EWAJC prior to September of the previous year. This can be done in writing directly to the committee or via the EWA dates submission form.
- The HOTY Class is to be run as an open class under article 238.2.2 or 273.
- The Horse of the Year classes, and the series, are considered to be most prestigious in Western Australia and clubs are asked to make sure that the classes are placed appropriately in the program, preferably between noon and 2pm, to highlight the nature of the class.

CLASS ENTRY AND PRIZEMONEY

- A Horse competing in a HOTY class may not compete in a EWAJ Bronze or Silver Leaderboard qualifier class at the same fixture.
- The EWAJC offers financial assistance of up to \$800 to each participating host club to help run the qualifier as per the conditions laid out by the EWAJC
- There is to be a minimum total cash prize money of \$1300 per class (EWA Jumping + club contributions).
- Vouchers or merchandise may be given in addition to the cash prize money total but may not supplement the cash prize money total as above.

LEADERBOARD

- Maintenance of the leader board is to be the responsibility of Equestrian WA.
- Points will be awarded from each round with 1st 10, 2nd 8, 3rd 6, 4th 5, 5th 4 and additionally each clear first round that is not placed- 1 point.
- The Horse of the Year leader board will be based on the performance of the horse
- Where a horse accrues a total of 16 penalties or more in the first-round of a series competition the horse does not accrue Leaderboard points.
- The winner of the leader board will be awarded a rug, trophy and prize at the annual EWA Awards night

CONDITIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSITANCE

In order to be eligible for financial assistance the host club must adhere to the guidelines as said above and the following conditions:

- The EWAJC offers sponsorship of up to \$800 to each participating host club for the purpose of cash prizemoney
- The host club is required to sign a sponsorship agreement prior to the event program being published or by 31 March each calendar year whichever comes first.
- Host Clubs are to seek the remaining \$500, if not more, amount of additional sponsorship/cash prize money
- Programs must be submitted to EWA Jumping a minimum of four (4) weeks prior to the event of 7 days prior to publication.
- The host club is asked to recognise the support from EWA Jumping in the programme stating that the class is part of the EWA Jumping Horse of the Year Series by including the follow clause in their program: This HOTY series round is proudly sponsored by EWA Jumping Rider Levies.
- If a rug is awarded for the class the host club is asked to recognise the support from EWA Jumping with the following statement printed on the rug: *sponsored by EWAJ Rider Levies*
- If not all placings are filled and therefore not all granted prizemoney is not rewarded and acquitted; the following amount will be deducted from the grant amount:

- The Host club running the Horse of the Year Series are required to acquit levies and submit the grant report to the EWAJC within eight (8) four (4) weeks after the event. (template can be found on the EWA website)
- Monies will be paid when the EWAJC is satisfied that the host club has met all of the funding conditions
- A host club may not run another EWA Jumping Series until all jumping rider levies are paid
 from the previous EWA Jumping series show hosted. If jumping rider levies are not paid by
 the end of the calendar year then the host club may not be eligible to apply to run an EWA
 Jumping series the following year; until the levies are paid.
