#### **NEWCOMERS:**

#### QUALIFING PERIOD FOR 2024 NEWCOMERS 17th APRIL 2023 TO 12th APRIL 2024

- No qualification is required to compete in the Newcomers provided the horse/pony has not competed under saddle prior to the start of the qualifying period 17<sup>th</sup> April 2023.
- Performance licences will be issued by the office and must be returned with entries.
- Competing in ridden breed classes prior to the qualifying period will render a horse/pony ineligible to compete as an EWA Newcomer. This includes any Pony Club competition.
- Horses/ponies are not eligible to enter if they have competed outside the qualifying period.
- Any horse or pony, having competed interstate during this period, will be required to provide proof of eligibility. Horses
  arriving from interstate or internationally must provide details of qualifying performances to the Show Horse Coordinator,
  prior to the Newcomer licence being issued.
- Horses/ponies must compete in a snaffle bit.
- Horses/ponies must have a current EWA registration at the time of qualifying.
- Owners and Riders must be current EWA financial members at the time of qualifying.
- Horses/ponies must have a current EWA Height Certificate at the time of qualifying.
- Horses/Ponies must have a current Newcomer competition licence.

Copy of Newcomers Licence must be attached to entry on Nominate in pdf format.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - please read carefully.**

This event is to be conducted under current EA rules and by-laws of Equestrian Australia (as amended) as well as these Conditions of Entry (together 'the rules')

Important Information – please read the Conditions of Entry – by entering the event the competitor will be accepting the Terms and Conditions of the event and is bound by 'the rules'.

- The onus is on the competitor to have full knowledge of the above rules. Rules can be downloaded from www.equestrian.org.au
- The organisers of EWA Show Horse reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any events they deem necessary on the day.
- Horse/pony may only compete as a show horse or show hunter.
- Riders must wear a current approved safety helmet and riding boots while mounted on any horse or pony at all times. Please
  refer to the EWA website for the new approved headwear. <a href="http://www.equestrian.org.au/content/current-approved-safety-standards-helmets">http://www.equestrian.org.au/content/current-approved-safety-standards-helmets</a>
- Rider's age will be as of the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024.
- The Judge's decision is final. Judges are not to be approached under ANY circumstances.
- Protests must be made in writing and be referred to the ground jury, a deposit of \$150.00 must be made with the lodgement of the protest, this is not refundable if the protest is not upheld.
- Show Ponies and Show Hunter Ponies not exceeding 12 hands must be ridden by a child rider 14 years of age and under.
- Show Ponies and Show Hunter Ponies over 12 hands can be ridden by a rider of any age unless otherwise specified on the program.
- BYO Alcohol is not permitted on the grounds.
- Dogs must be always on a leash.
- All prizes must be collected on the day or forfeited.
- Failure to abide by the rules may lead to disqualification and loss of prizes.
- No refunds after close of entries. Refunds will only be given with a veterinary or medical certificate dated prior to the show and provided to the EWA Show Horse Committee within 7 days of the competition, less \$25.00 administration fee.
- Random swabbing may take place in accordance with the EA National Medication Control Policy and the Equine Anti-Doping
  and Medical Control rules.

#### RIDER FALL AND CLEARANCE

- Riders must be mounted on entering and leaving the arena on penalty of elimination.
- If during a workout, or on the circle there is a fall of horse and/or rider it will result in elimination from that class.
- If a horse leaves the workout area, other than at the direction of a judge or official, it will entail elimination from that class.
- The Judge has the power to eliminate a horse or rider if it is deemed by the judge to be erratic and unruly.
- In the event of a fall by horse or competitor, the competitor must report to the Event Medical Officer for clearance. It will be the decision of the Ground Jury (informed the Medical Officer in the case of a rider or a vet in the case of a horse), as to whether the rider or horse can continue to compete at the event.

#### 2025 ENSW SOUTHERN CROSS SHOW HORSE SPECTACULAR QUALIFIER

To be eligible for the Newcomers at the 2025 ENSW Southern Cross Show Horse Spectacular, horses competing in the Newcomer classes must not have competed under saddle at any show prior to 1 January 2024 and must have commenced under saddle before 31st December 2024. 1st, 2nd & 3rd placegetters will be invited to compete at the 2025 ENSW Southern Cross Show Horse Spectacular.

#### **INDEMNITY**

Competitors indemnify Equestrian WA, the Organising Committee and Riverside Riding Club against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse, and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity. Neither Equestrian WA, nor the Organising Committee or their appointed officials accept any liability for any accident, theft or illness to horses, riders, grooms or any person or property whatsoever.
