The 2015 SHPC Show jumping Series will consist of **3 events** that will be held at the Serpentine Horse and Pony club grounds at Karnup Rd, Serpentine.

The series will be open to PCAWA and Open/ Non-PCAWA members (who have annual PCAWA Insurance or EA insurance).

Each event will offer various heights (45cm ~1.05cm) run as optimum time or AM7 classes.

Series points will be allocated from 1st to 6th place for each of the 22 categories and will be allocated as follows:

1st 7 points
2nd 6 points
3rd 5 points
4th 4 points
5th 3 points
6th 2 points
Completion of a jumping round without being eliminated 1 point

RULES OF THE SERIES

Pre entries only- no entries on the day

Competitors must have **PCAWA insurance cover**, to be sited on the day when requested.

Open riders (18+ only) are able to purchase annual PCAWA insurance from \$40 online from the PCAWA website.

Riders under 18 years that are not a member of a Pony Club are not permitted to compete at this show.

Riders must wear long sleeve shirts (open competitors) or Formal Pony Club uniform.

PCAWA gear checking rules will apply and competitors are responsible for being aware of these rules.

Competitors must compete in 2 or more events to be eligible for the series, and must be present at the final event.

Organisers reserve the right to amend/ join classes as required and have the absolute discretion to refuse entry to, or eject any competitor from any class, event or series for any reason.

Organisers reserve the right to determine and amend prizes (including rugs) for each and any class, event or the series according to the level of entries or any other reason.

Age groups will be determined by age as of January 1st, 2015.

Points are allocated based on horse/rider combination. Combinations can only compete at 3 consecutive heights at each event.

Series placegetters will be announced at the final event on May 2nd, 2015.

Horse /Rider combinations may compete in both arenas, as long as a maximum of three consecutive height rounds are jumped per event. If a rider chooses to compete in both arenas, they may be required to jump their higher height rounds first.

No horse/ Rider combination will be eligible for more than one High Points Winner or Runner –up prize. In the event of one combination being in this position, the higher height arena will take precedence.

PRIZES

Individual series events

- * Ribbons and vouchers/prizes to third place
- * Ribbons third to sixth place

Series Prizes

 * Awarded for overall PCAWA junior, PCAWA senior and Open high point rider in Arena 1

- * And overall high point PCAWA and Open rider in Ring 2
- * Rugs (or equivalent) and rosettes for series winners in each ring
- * Prize/saddle cloth and rosettes for runners-up
- * Rosettes, Vouchers/Prizes 3rd to 6th place
