Article 114 – Horse Identification

3. From 01 July 2008, to get registered with EA, all horses must have a microchip meeting ISO 11784 & ISO 11785 inserted.
4. From 01 July 2011, all horses participating in Official competition must have a microchip meeting ISO 11784 & ISO 11785 inserted. (Amended 16 May 2008)
