EA CLUB INSURANCE

As an EA affiliated club you have access to the EA National Insurance Programme, which offers clubs Personal Accident, Public Liability, Professional Indemnity and Management Liability Insurance.

EA COACH INSURANCE

As an EA affiliated coach, you have access to the EA National Insurance Programme, which offers 24/7 Personal Accident, Public Liability and Professional Indemnity Insurance whilst engaged in coaching activities (within the scope of your accreditation).



OTHER BENEFITS



COMPETITION PATHWAYS

Whether you are a pleasure rider simply wanting to have fun with your horse or a seasoned competitor at the peak of your chosen discipline, EWA membership allows you to participate at events across the state (where EWA membership is accepted). Achievements at all levels are recognised through prizes at events, leaderboards and annual awards for each discipline.



HORSE REGISTRATION AND PERFORMANCE RECORDS

Members can register their horses to compete in official competitions, for biosecurity purposes or to secure a name. Members can also view their competition performance results on MyEA.



SUPPORT THE SPORT

Part of all membership fees goes to Equestrian Australia in the form of a National Levy which allows the continued administration, development and regulation of the sport on a national and international level. By becoming a member, you will be part of a structured organisation that formulates rules and regulations, monitors the sport, and also contributes to the training of officials and coaches. HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAMS

The EWA High Performance Programs offers members development opportunities through talent identification, pathways training clinics and state team representation. Riders who achieve good consistent results in their chosen discipline(s) will be invited to join the High Performance Squads.

EWA offers a number of youth development and competition pathways for young riders including the State Interschool Championships, Rising Stars Development Squad, and discipline-specific youth leaderboards.

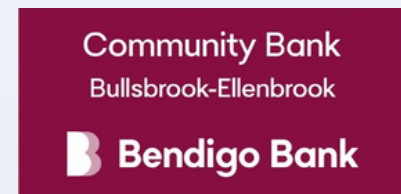
