



# 2024 Saddles Plus Interschool Eventing Series

## Rules and Procedures

*Equestrian WA is proud to announce the 2024 Saddles Plus Interschool Eventing Series held in conjunction with the Equestrian WA Interschool State Championship presented by Ramsay's Horse Transport and Low Loader Logistics.*

### **Series**

The 2024 Interschools Eventing Series will be run over the following three (3) events:

- **Capel CCN**  
*16<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> March, Capel Regional Equestrian Centre, Capel WA*
- **WAYER CCI**  
*30<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> March, State Equestrian Centre, Brigadoon WA*
- **SOUTH WEST HORSE TRIALS CCN**  
*27<sup>th</sup> - 28<sup>th</sup> April, South West Horse Trials, Harvey WA*

Riders must compete at two of the three events to qualify for the eventing series.

Awards will be given for EvAJ65 through to 2\*.

### **2024 Saddles Plus Interschools Eventing Series Rules**

Students will not be separated into primary and secondary school to align with the EA Interschool National Championships. EvA65 is not offered by the Interschools National Championships.

Combinations will be placed in the championship series on their best two score (penalties wise) of the competitions they complete, i.e. not eliminated, withdrawn or retired. If riders do not complete two or more competitions, they will not be included in the overall series results.

To be eligible for placing in the series, riders must be a **Competitive EA Member**.

Participant Members are more than welcome to compete but will not be included in the final placings for the series.

Combinations need to nominate that they are riding in the Saddles Plus Interschools Eventing Series when they enter each event. As of 2024, there is no fees to enter the series.

Riders competing at 2\* level, may compete in any of the following classes, the CCN2\*-S, CCI2\*-S and CCI2\*-L.

Riders are encouraged but not enforced to wear their school uniforms whilst competing. Both clothing options must comply with EA ruling.

There are no qualifiers required for the 2024 Interschools Eventing Series.



### **2024 Saddles Plus Interschools Eventing Series Scoring**

All scores will be calculated from the official results from each event. From these scores, the two lowest penalties will be averaged to decide who will win for their height in the series:

**ie. Capel= 28 penalties, WAYER= 67.3 penalties & Harvey=33.2 penalties =30.6 penalties.**

Every score will be rounded to the second decimal point where applicable.

In the event where two riders have the same average score, the higher place will be determined by who attended the most events of the three available. If they are still the same, the higher place will be determined by who received the lowest penalties out of their completed events.

To be eligible for the series, riders must complete two events at the same height. Points and penalties will not be carried across heights.

### **2024 Saddles Plus Interschools Eventing Champion Event Combination Scoring**

The Champion Event Combination will be determined by which combination attended, and who scored the most points across all three events. Points will be allocated across the whole event placings per height, including those who have not nominated for the series. There will only be one (1) Champion Rider presented across all heights.

### **2024 Saddles Plus Interschools Eventing Series Awards**

- **Event Awards:**

Each event in the series will receive a rosette from 1<sup>st</sup> through to 6<sup>th</sup>. In the event where there are less than six (6) interschool combinations, placings will be reduced. These scores are collected by the EWA Office from the Official Event Scores.

- **Series Awards:**

As according to the 'Series Rules' above, each height will be presented with the series winners from 1<sup>st</sup> through to 6<sup>th</sup> at the Interschools WA Awards Night. In the event where there are less than six (6) riders qualified for the series, placings will be reduced.

- **Champion Combination Award:**

As according to the 'Champion Combination' above, one combination will be awarded as the Saddles Plus Interschools Champion Event Combination. This will be presented at the Interschools WA Awards night.
