OUR UNIQUE HOME


Located just 35 minutes from the Perth CBD in the picturesque Swan Valley region is WA's premier equestrian facility - the State Equestrian Centre (SEC). The SEC is hosted on 66 hectares of prime sporting land positioned on the banks of the serene Swan River and nestled amongst the beautiful Bells Rapids, world class wineries, top notch restaurants and many more local attractions.

Home to Equestrian Western Australia (EWA), the SEC supports young riders and elite development squads in their pursuit of equestrian excellence, as well as recreational riders and clinicians covering all aspects of the diverse equestrian community.

EWA has managed the SEC since it was opened in 1985. Each year, the home of equestrian sport in WA hosts over 300 events with approximately 100,000 visitors and 14,000 horses visiting the SEC.

In addition to the state of the art equestrian facilities, the SEC also offers a relaxing and picturesque venue for hosting conferences, meetings and training for corporate groups with three conference rooms and a bar area.





THE BENEFITS OF COMMUNITY SPORT

A social return on investment study commissioned by SportWest has revealed that WA organised sport and its 700,000 participants return \$7.10 in economic and social benefit for every dollar of cost each year, totalling a gross benefit of \$10.3 billion per annum.

The gross benefit can be broken down to economic & employment \$4.85 billion, physical & mental health \$3.02 billion and personal wellbeing & broader social benefits \$2.39 billion. The mental health benefit delivered by sport alone is \$1.8 billion per year.

Participation in community sport reduces the burden on our health care system, it teaches resilience and builds life skills, improves productivity, reduces the risk of crime, reduces rates of suicide and improves linkages within local communities.

In addition to quantifying the social return on investment, the study has revealed that community sport in WA survives and thrives on some 41.9 million volunteer hours every year, the equivalent of 21,511 full time workers at a social cost of \$852 million.

A SPORT GROWING IN POPULARITY

A recent Australian Government report revealed Equestrian ranks ninth in participation numbers across Australia for Females aged 15+. More than 220,000 females in this demographic participate in equestrian sport. Significantly, more than 100,000 of these participants live in regional and rural areas.




