- A horse may be ridden by different riders across the Series, but each pairing is considered a separate entry.
- Rider classes are exempt from this rule.

3. *If the tie is still not broken, the highest result from the EWA Winter Gala will be the decider.*
4. *If the tie is still not broken having regard to points 1 to 3 above, an equal award may be given.*
