Entries

Entry forms will be available early August.

Arenas:

3 arenas will be in use, 2 grass arenas and 1 all weather grit arena. Plenty of warm up space available. A full size warm up arena is also available. Separate lunging area.

Ground Fees:

\$2.5 per day per horse.

Catering:

Full canteen both days.

Scratchings:

A refund of entry fees will only be provided if a vet or doctors certificate is presented.

Helper Duties:

All riders are required to provide a helper. YOU CANNOT LIST ANOTHER RIDER AS YOUR HELPER. Only riders riding ONE horse are allowed to do SELF HELP. Your helper will be required for either 2 jobs or an extended helper job if you are riding more than one horse at the competition.
