Conditions of Entry - Showjumping

1. Horses may compete in only one showjumping arena.
2. Maximum of 3 rounds over 3 heights for each horse.
3. No double bridles.

Main arena classes may go higher if sufficient interest and the judge approves the surface.

Helper conditions

1. *Provision of a helper is a condition of entry. Failure to complete helper duties and/or notify of emergency withdrawal, may result in further participation in club events being refused.*
2. *Adult riders may provide self-help before or immediately following the event.*
3. *Riders (or parent/guardian) are responsible for ensuring they are capable of completing their nominated job, including health considerations and adequate supervision of minors.*

FACILITIES

1. *Limited yards available, some under cover and others open. Yards may not be saved or reserved for other patrons.*
2. *Grass jumping arenas. All weather dressage and warm up surfaces*
3. *Canteen will be open.*
4. *Lots of shade, indoor seating, and secure play area for young children.*

<i>Ground fees apply to all horses on the grounds – whether entered into a class or not.</i>	\$2.50 per horse		
3. Entry Fees – Package Deal			
<i>Package includes 1 x dressage test, 3 rounds of showjumping, and all eligible events in show horse and games for one horse/rider combination. Event members are not eligible for show horse events.</i>	\$60 per combination		
4. Entry Fees – by Discipline			
Dressage <i>Maximum of 2 tests.</i>	\$15 per test		
Encouragement Showjumping (30-60cm) <i>Maximum of 3 rounds per horse at 3 consecutive heights. Combinations must not compete in the main show jumping arena on the same day.</i>	\$10 per round		
Main Showjumping (60cm +) <i>Maximum of 3 rounds per horse at 3 consecutive heights.</i>	\$10 per round		
Show Horse/ Have a go Hacking <i>Includes all eligible classes. Full members of BH&PC (Inc) only</i>	\$20 per combination.		
Games <i>Includes all eligible classes</i>	\$15 per combination.		
Lead Line & First Ridden <i>Includes all eligible classes. This arena is for very young riders that would benefit from a small, closed area and consideration of their age. Riders may not compete in any other classes on the day.</i>	\$20 per combination		
On the day Entry Fee <i>Processing fee for entries on the day. Standard entries available through Nominate close 10pm Sunday before the event.</i>	\$10 per form		
Notes: <i>No refunds. All parties must follow EA and BH&PC (Inc) Codes of Conduct, rules and agreements. Adult must accompany minors. Failure to complete helper jobs is a serious matter – only genuine emergencies notified to officials considered reasonable excuse.
