At my local club, Busselton Horse and Pony Club, I have held the role of club president (3yrs) and past secretary of the club (4yrs). I am also the immediate past secretary of the Southwest Zone of Pony Club WA (2yrs) and now the Treasurer, but have been on the committee for over 15yrs. In my work life I am on a number of committees and a member of the school executive some of which I run as the chair and others as a committee member.
