Riders are asked to check to check the **draw and helper** roster and notify the event organiser of any problems prior to the final draw being posted on Thursday.

Helpers are asked to present to the event office 15 minutes prior to the allocated helper time. Helper bonds will be returned to the card used to pay for entries the week following the event. The final draw will be posted online on the [EWA Event](#). Jumping classes will run straight through.

Riders competing in both dressage and jumping classes – dressage times take priority over jumping classes. Please notify the jumping marshal prior to your class if you anticipate a clash to adjust your jumping order. All other riders are expected to jump in draw order.

Weather forecast and EA Hot Weather Policy – The while we appreciate the maximum temperature for Saturday 9 February is high the Wet Bulb Globe Temperature used to assess heat stress vulnerability in horses is forecast to remain below 33 throughout the duration of the event with majority of classes completed will be completed by 9:30am and all events completed by 11:00am.

- Riders are asked to read the [EA Hot Weather Policy](#) and note – *The primary responsibility for the welfare of horses competing and exercising during hot weather lies with the rider of the horse.*
- We strongly suggest competitors leave the grounds as early in the day as possible following their event/s to avoid transporting horses in the hottest part of the day. Dressage scores will be available online www.nominate.com.au/scoreboard/results and riders are welcome to leave a self-addressed envelope in the event office to have their test posted to enabling riders to leave the grounds early.

EA Memberships and Competition Licences – A small number of competitors do not have current memberships or competition licences.
