## CLASSES

## **HELPER DUTIES:**

- All competitors must provide a helper over the age of 15 years OR pay a \$70 No Help Fee. Job preferences submitted with entry will be considered but not guaranteed.
- Limited self-help is available.
- Self-help is <u>not</u> available to riders of more than one horse, unless completed prior to the event. Riders of two or more horses may elect to pay a No Help Fee of \$70 or help pre-event but only if negotiated with the event secretary.

## WITHDRAWALS
