**Cross Country Course:** All courses have been newly constructed by FEI International course designer Mr John Nicholson since the flooding in 2017. The course is situated on the plains of the Swan River and includes both permanent and transportable type fences. There is a water complex and good open grassed country for galloping.

**ENTRIES:** Entries and Entry Information will be available on [www.ktrials.com.au](http://www.ktrials.com.au) Pay online with Ktrials. When entering on KTRIALS please enter an 'EMERGENCY CONTACT PERSON AND CONTACT NUMBER OF THAT PERSON WHO WILL BE IN ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT!'

**Late Entries:** A \$50 late fee will apply after closing date if entry is accepted.

**Helpers:** PLEASE NOTE THERE IS **NO NO-HELP FEE**. **ALL RIDERS MUST SUPPLY A HELPER OVER 16 YEARS OF AGE**. We will be extremely appreciative of people volunteering for cross country jump judges! If you are riding more than 1 horse please be aware that you will have an extended, or multiple, helper duties. **Paid database helpers must be entered on Ktrials with a "DB" helper name and phone number. Please prefix the name with "DB".**

**Withdrawals:** Full refund of entry (less 10% admin fee) before the closing date. Refund of entries will be in accordance with EA National Rules (i.e. NO REFUND of entries after closing date) however a proportion of fees may be refunded if: (a) sufficient notice of withdrawal is given and (b) **a helper is provided on the day**. *Please note you are obliged to notify the Organising Committee (OC) of your intent to withdraw. It is requested that you do so as soon as possible.*
