CROSS COUNTRY COURSE

Jumps are of a very high standard over an undulating course with a wide open track including a large water complex. EvA95 is for the more experienced prelim combination and the EvA80 is encouraging.

The Ev65 course is a great introduction to the Wooroloo Event. It utilises the flatter areas of the grounds and is designed to give horses and riders the confidence to go on and tackle the higher grades at this venue.

Please enter your emergency contact name and mobile number.

This is not your "next of kin", this is a person who is prepared to assist if you are unable to continue being responsible for the care of your horse at the Competition. This person could be responsible for contacting your next of kin.

OFF THE TRACK

Make sure you register your horse's Off the Track details with your Ktrials entry.

Only horses registered before entries close will be eligible for Off the Track awards.

HELPERS/VOLUNTEERS

It is a condition of entry that all riders provide a Helper/Volunteer over the age of 16 years.

Job preferences as submitted on online entry will be considered but not guaranteed.

All helper duties will be approximately 3 to 4 hours and may take place while your child/partner etc is riding. The helper for a rider competing with more than one horse may be required to complete multiple duties or an extended session of help.

PHTA thanks their helpers in advance for attending to their designated duties in a timely manner.

SELF HELP

- Self help is limited and will **ONLY** be permitted by prior arrangement with the Event Secretary.
- Self help is not available to riders of more than one horse unless completed prior to the event.
- Self helpers who have not selected a pre event duty busy bee will be allocated canteen and will either be one 3-4 hour shift or 2 shorter shifts.
- Paid help is not self help.

PRE/POST EVENT HELPER DUTIES

- Busy Bee
- Dressage Arena Set Up
- XC Course Flagging
- XC Course Decorating
- Brush Cutting/Delivery
- Event clean up including arena grading/course de-flagging

PAID HELPER DUTIES

Riders intending to use paid help must do so through the WA Helper Duty Database. Please contact Kirsten Twining - wahdd@yahoo.com Use the code **DB** in front of the helper's name and nominate **XCJJ** as the helper duty.

BUSY BEE

Busy Bee participation is in lieu of helper duty. Those intending to provide self help are recommended to attend the busy bee to complete their duty.

The Busy Bee will be held on Saturday 10th August however there are limited tasks that can be allocated to helpers the week preceding the event on request to the event secretary.

WITHDRAWALS

Via Ktrials until close of entries. Withdrawals prior to the Event closing on KTrials will receive a full refund less an admin fee.

After close of entries, the secretary must be notified of withdrawals via email: pht@hotmail.com.au It is requested that you do so as soon as possible.

REFUNDS

Full refund on withdrawal of entry before closing date (less 10% online admin fee).

Refund of entries after closing date, will consist of **EA Levy, Medical Levy, Ground Fee and the EADCMP fee (where applicable).**

A portion of fees MAY be refunded at the Committee's discretion if:

HELMETS

All helmets must be tagged as per Rule 538.1.1 of the 2019 EA Eventing Rules.

GO PRO HELMET CAMERAS

All Helmet Cameras must be checked by the Technical Delegate at the event. Times for Helmet Cam checking TBC

NOTE: Only video nominees sanctioned by the Technical Delegate will be used for video review!

ICE

Will be on sale at the grounds at 8.00am until 8.30am on Saturday morning of the XC on the south side of the showjumping arena near the toilet block (Committee carpark). Cost will be \$5.00 per bag. Please bring the correct change. Otherwise available from the Wooroloo Store or Chidlow Growers Market.

REFRESHMENTS

A variety of refreshment options will be available over the weekend and will include the Pink Moo Coffee Van, food vans and the canteen will be operating during the day on Friday, Saturday, Sunday. The Canteen will provide breakfast on all days.

MEDICAL ARMBANDS

Whilst it is not required to wear an armband during Cross Country, if you do have a medical condition or have recently had a head injury, it is necessary for you to wear a medical armband. A form is available from the Office which should also be filled out and will be handed to the Paramedics for their information. This is your responsibility and is important.

PARKING

Due to FEI regulations, classes will have designated parking areas.

Parking instructions must be adhered to or you will be asked to relocate.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Accommodation is available at El Caballo Blanco approx. 7 kms from the grounds
- Shower facilities are available.
- No power is provided.

- There are no yards on site and competitors must make their own yards, the size of which will be limited to accommodate all competitors.
- Yards must be made according to the EWA rules, no tape allowed.
- Competitors are asked to ensure their area is left free of litter.
- Please spread manure rather than bagging please!!
