JUDGES: The Judge's decision is final in all cases. Judges are not to be approached by any competitor or spectator.

DRESS: Riders competing in the encourager lunchtime ring, Pony Club Uniform is acceptable.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash.

<u>Please note:</u> To compete at any GCEC show/fixture competitors must be either an E.W.A., SHC, or GCEC member. All competitors must sign a Member Release & Waiver of Liability and a CODE OF CONDUCT form before they compete

E.W.A. Levy of \$2.50 per start or \$15.00 maximum per rider for the day will apply. (Nominations include \$2.00 ground fee). Max 2 rounds per horse 1.05m & up, Max 3 rounds per horse up to 1.00m.

Entry Fee: Members: \$10.00 / class/ horse Plus EWA Levy

Non Members: \$15.00 / class / horse Plus EWA Levy (Non GCEC Members must be EWA members)

Dressage: Entries close Wednesday 8th April @ 4pm.
