

SADDLES PLUS STATE INTERSCHOOL EQUESTRIAN FESTIVAL

EVENTING COMPETITOR INFORMATION

This competition will be held at Brigadoon CCN-S on the 31 Oct – 1 Nov 2020

- Riders must be current financial Equestrian Australia members (minimum Participant Junior) and membership number must be included with entry together with name of school and school year
- All Interschools riders need to hold a minimum of a valid EA Participant junior membership and have their horse registered and microchipped for this event
- All Interschool competitors are to wear shirt and tie/stock with school jumper, school vest or school hacking jacket (not school blazer), white or light coloured breeches or jodhpurs and riding boots (full grain gaiters matching boots are permitted). School logo must be worn on either the school jumper, school vest, or school Jacket, along with school logo on saddle cloths. In the case of hot weather the OC may allow for jumpers and jackets to be removed and shirts underneath must be sleeved. For other attire, refer to EA rules for Eventing.
- Interschool riders may have a maximum of two rides in different classes (One Interschool horse per class) but only the best placing result will count towards Interschool points.
- Competitors can compete as an Interschool competitor from EvA65 level through to the CCN2*. *(Please note that any performances at the 2020 Brigadoon CCN-S cannot be used as a qualifier for Australian championships).*
- Interschool riders ride within their chosen class, so if Interschool rider "A" in the Junior EvA95 class finishes 3rd in the class, but is the highest placed Interschool rider they will receive the 3rd place prize from Brigadoon CCN-S as well as 1st place prize from Interschool WA.
- Interschool ribbons will be awarded to the 1st – 6th (Points will be awarded as per 2020 Interschool's schedule), however there will be no presentations made at the Brigadoon CCN for Interschool riders. Presentations including for overall awards will take place at Interschool WA State Championships Awards Event (Saturday, 28 November 2020).
- Interschool riders must add extra \$15 per horse/rider competition to their entry fee.

Qualification of State Team for Australian Interschool Championship

Due to the cancellation of the 2020 Australian Interschool Championship, this event will not serve as a qualifier for the national event. Likewise, the Interschool Leaderboard Competition has been suspended for 2020.

Proof of Competency - Eventing

For the safety of both horses and riders, entrants no longer need to qualify to compete at this event. However, for the safety of both riders and horses, entrants will be required to provide that they are able to compete at their entered height of level (or below).

Horse/Rider combination must achieve ONE 'proof of competency' performance at an Eventing Competition run by EA or PCAWA Affiliated Eventing Competition officiated by current EA Officials between April 2019 to the close of entries.

PROOF OF COMPETENCY REQUIREMENTS:

A qualification performance is achieved by completing a competition within minimum parameters of all round performance as follows:

- a) Dressage Test: not more than 42 (58%) penalty points.
- b) Cross Country Test: 0 penalties at obstacles; not more than 75 seconds exceeding the optimum time in the Cross Country Test.
- c) Jumping Test: not more than 12 penalties at obstacles.

Horse/Rider combination competing in Eventing Championship Classes are **ineligible to enter Combined Training Championship Classes at the Interschool Equestrian Festival** in the same year.
