<b>Times:</b>	<i>Course walk:</i> 9.00 am -11.30 pm. <i>XC jump judges briefing:</i> 11.00 – 11.30 pm. <i>Competition commences:</i> 12.00 pm
<b>Event rules:</b>	This event will be run under modified PCAWA Hickstead Competition Rules. Entering this event constitutes implicit knowledge and acceptance of these rules. PCAWA gear checking rules will apply.
<b>Conditions of entry:</b>	Horses/ponies must be 4 years of age or more to enter this event. Riders must be 8 years of age as of 1 January 2016. All riders must be PCAWA or EA members.
<b>Course:</b>	The competition will consist of 9 showjumping obstacles followed immediately by 9 cross country obstacles. The course will be designed to be encouraging for young or inexperienced horse and rider combinations.
<b>Entry fee:</b>	PCAWA Members: \$25.00 (plus \$10 ground fee if not a KRPC ground use member) Non-PCAWA members: \$35 (plus \$10 ground fee if not a KRPC ground use member)

<b>Application of penalties:</b>	<i>Showjumping:</i> Normal penalties as per Table A will apply to the showjumping section of the course. <i>Cross country:</i> Normal cross country penalties will apply to this section of the course. Riders may not wear any watches or timing equipment on course. If 3 refusals are incurred at either a showjump or cross country obstacle, or 4 refusals across the whole course, the competitor will no longer be considered competitive (eliminated), but can continue on course at their own risk. If riders are deemed to be time wasting (e.g. dropping down to a walk or slow trot near end of course), this will incur 20 penalties. In the case of a fall of horse or rider, the combination will be eliminated, and the rider must discontinue, remain unmounted and present to the medical officer upon leaving the course. Riders will be placed according to the lowest number of penalties. In the case of a tie, closest to optimum time will be deemed the winner.
<b>Event classes:</b>	<p><i>Only one height/age class per horse/rider combination is permitted.</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 1.05m, Open age</li> <li>2. 95cm, Open age</li> <li>3. 80cm, 17 years and over</li> <li>4. 80cm, 16 years and under</li> <li>5. 65cm, 17 years and over</li> <li>6. 65cm, 16 years and under</li> <li>7. 45cm, 17 years and over</li> <li>8. 45cm, 16 years and under.</li> </ol>
<b>Draw and helper duties:</b>	The draw and assigned helper duties will be posted at KRPC at 9.00am on Saturday 5 March 2016. All riders are expected to nominate a helper.
<b>Medical armbands:</b>	The wearing of medical armbands (on upper, left arm) whilst riding is compulsory.
<b>Back protectors:</b>	The wearing of back protectors during this competition is compulsory.
<b>Number holders:</b>	Riders must have approved competitor number holders/bibs. All horses must have a saddle cloth or bridle number in addition to the rider number.
<b>Helmet cameras:</b>	Helmet cameras are not permitted.
<b>Medical assistance:</b>	There will be a first aid service on grounds during the competition.
<b>Veterinary assistance:</b>	<i>Vet on grounds:</i> Dr Colin Davey (mob: 0429 631 333)
<b>Canteen:</b>	There will be canteen facilities available.
<b>Dogs:</b>	Dogs have to be kept on a lead at all times.
