CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Advanced Feeds 2026 Equestrian Western Australia (EWA) Horse & Rider of the Year (HROTY) is to be run under Equestrian Australia (EA) rules and any other rules formulated by the Organising Committee (OC). We strongly recommend that all competitors obtain a copy of the relevant EA Rules through the Equestrian WA website www.wa.equestrian.org.au.

It is a condition of entry that the owners and exhibitors are familiar with and abide by the EA National Show Horse Rules and rules that may be introduced by the OC

These Rules are to be read in conjunction with the EA Disciplinary By-Laws, Member Protection Policy and Medication Control Policy. Ignorance of the rules will not be accepted as an excuse for any breach of the rules. The appointment of a Steward or other Official, whether or not provided for in these rules, does not absolve the competitor from such responsibility.

Making an entry into this event constitutes implicit acceptance of these rules.

SWABBING

Drug testing of horses (swabbing) will occur in accordance with the EA National Medical Control Policy and the Equine Anti-Doping and Medical Control rules. Full rule details are available at www.equestrian.org.au

- EA has adopted the anti-doping policy of the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority
- Stimulating or calming drugs in any shape or form are forbidden

SENSORY HAIRS

Please refer to the current EA General Regulations Article 141 Protection of Horses.

A horse's sensory hairs may not be clipped and/or shaven or otherwise modified in any way under penalty of elimination from the event.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES

Entries close 9.00 PM Friday 14th August 2026. All fees must be paid at the time of entry via www.nominate.com.au.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fees will not be refunded after the close of entries.

In the event of a horse or rider being unfit to compete, a medical or vet certificate must be received by the office within 72 hours prior to the event and any refund will be at the discretion of the organising committee. There will be no further discussion after the decision has been made and given in writing. WORKOUTS

All ridden classes will have a set workout.

OFF THE TRACK RIDDEN THOROUGHBRED & STANDARD BRED

Off the Track classes are for retired racehorses & pacers.

ELIGIBILITY

Thoroughbreds must be registered with the Australian Studbook.

Standardbreds must be registered with Australian Harness Racing.

Unraced, untrials and unnamed horses are all eligible to enter.

Horses do not need to be EA registered if they are only competing in these classes, however a minimal recreational membership is encouraged for insurance purposes.

Open to EA Members & Non-members; entries accepted by signing a waiver with entry.

Horses must be entered in their racing name, and all horses must hold an Off the Track Passport; that can be obtained at no charge from <https://www.offthetrackwa.com.au/off-the-track-wa-passport/> a copy is to be supplied with your entry.

FASHIONS ON THE FIELD

Fashions on the Field' (FOTF) will be judged by three judges using a point system who will be assessing outfits, which should be suitable for a racing carnival, showing individual flair, and horses will be judged on presentation.

Judges will be scoring as follows:

HORSE PRESENTATION	(25 Points)
FASHION APPROPRIATENESS FOR THE EVENT	(25 Points)
OVERALL STYLE, GROOMING & PRESENTATION	(25 Points)
ATTENTION TO DETAIL (MILLINERY, CLUTCH, JEWELLERY)	(25 Points)
TOTAL	100 POINTS

No led workout will be conducted – During the horse scoring phase the horse will present to the judge for viewing.

CLOTHING RULES

The style, originality and suitability of the outfit should be appropriate for attending a racing carnival.

Narrow shoulder straps and strapless clothing are strongly discouraged.

Millinery (hats & fascinators) are encouraged.

The elements of your outfit should complement the horse.

Closed footwear must be worn at all times – No stiletto heels permitted in the indoor arena.

NOTE: Horses are permitted to have a handler who must also wear closed toe shoes and be dressed appropriately for FOTF.

HORSE RULES

Horses can only be used for one entrant per class.

OFF THE TRACK SHOW HORSE LEADERBOARD

Points gained will contribute to the 2026 EWA Show Horse Off the Track Leaderboard Awards.

Points will be awarded as follows in the Led & Ridden Classes

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STABLING

Stable bookings will be opened closer to the event, date to be advertised on the FB event page.

ARENA ACCESS & FAMILIARISATION

Access to the arena will be available – times to be confirmed, limited to Competitors who have classes on the day only:

INDEMNITY

Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted, undertake to indemnify Equestrian WA, The State Equestrian Centre, the OC, Officials & Sponsors against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse, and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity. Riders are required to sign the declaration form included in the entry section. Neither Equestrian WA, The State Equestrian Centre, nor the Organising Committee or their appointed officials accept any liability for any accident, theft or illness to horses, riders, grooms or any person or property whatsoever.

Important Notes:

- Article 116 of the EA General Regulations, which apply to this event, entitles the Organising Committee in its absolute and unfettered discretion to reject any entry, even after an entry has been accepted.
- This Competition Schedule is subject to change as Sponsorship Agreements are finalised.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the judges and/or alter the timetable.
