# INTRODUCING THE OTTWA PASSPORT

---

The Off the Track WA (OTTWA) Passport forms an important part of the commitments outlined in the WA Racehorse Welfare Plan.

The initiative is designed to assist Racing and Wagering Western Australia (RWWA) in tracing and connecting retired racehorses in WA and gain a better understanding of their location and life after racing.

Owners of retired standardbred and thoroughbred racehorses are encouraged to create an OTTWA Passport account and register any horses in their care.

Through this a record of the horse's details such as previous and current owners, locations and use will be maintained.

The detail collated through the OTTWA Passport will provide useful information to RWWA programs and initiatives, which support horses and their owners in the transition from racing to retirement.

## HORSE REGISTRATION

Q

How do I access my 50% discount on Base Horse Registrations?

A

On the EWA Base Horse Registration form, located on the [EWA website](#), simply tick that you are an OTTWA Passport Holder and enter your Horse ID Number in the boxes provided.

## EWA MEMBERSHIP

Q

How do I access \$15 off my EWA Annual Membership?

A

On the EWA Membership Registration form, located on the [EWA website](#), simply tick that you are an OTTWA Passport Holder and enter your Horse ID Number in the boxes provided.

In addition, head to this [link via the EWA website](#) to enter your details so EWA can process your rebate. You can fill in the form at anytime to claim your rebate - it doesn't have to be at the same time you pay for your membership.

## COMPETITION PATHWAYS

Members can register their horses to compete in official competitions, for biosecurity purposes or to secure a name. Members can also view their competition performance results on MyEA.

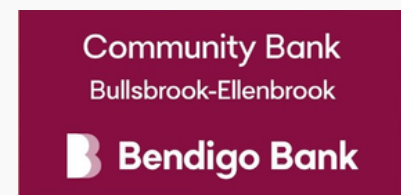
