Conditions of Entry



The 2026 EWA Autumn Pageant Off the Track is to be run under Equestrian Australia (EA) rules and any other rules formulated by the Organising Committee (OC). We strongly recommend that all competitors obtain a copy of the relevant EA Rules through the Equestrian WA website www.wa.equestrian.org.au.

It is a condition of entry that the owners and exhibitors are familiar with and abide by the EA National Show Horse Rules and rules that may be introduced by the OC.

These Rules are to be read in conjunction with the EA Disciplinary By-Laws, Member Protection Policy and Medication Control Policy. Ignorance of the rules will not be accepted as an excuse for any breach of the rules. The appointment of a Steward or other Official, whether or not provided for in these rules, does not absolve the competitor from such responsibility.

Making an entry into this event constitutes implicit acceptance of these rules.

EWA OFF THE TRACK SHOW HORSE LEADERBOARD SERIES

Event One marks the commencement of the three-part High Point Series for the Show Horse and Off the Track Leaderboard Series. Points for Event One will be awarded based on official placings in the led and ridden classes.

Champion 3 points, Reserve Champion 2 points

Points earned at Event One are non-transferable and must be accumulated by the same horse–rider combination throughout the series. Any change of rider or substitution of horse after Event One will result in the combination beginning a new points tally. No bonus points apply at this event.

SWABBING

Drug testing of horses (swabbing) will occur in accordance with the EA National Medical Control Policy and the Equine Anti-Doping and Medical Control rules. Full rule details are available at www.equestrian.org.au

- EA has adopted the anti-doping policy of the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority
- Stimulating or calming drugs in any shape or form are forbidden

SENSORY HAIRS

Since July 2022, a horse's sensory hairs may not be clipped and/or shaven or otherwise modified in any way under penalty of elimination from the event. Individual sensory hairs may be removed by a veterinarian to prevent pain or discomfort for the horse. Areas of hair that must be clipped, shaven or removed to allow veterinary treatment are exempt from this rule. Horses that have a veterinary exemption must provide proof in the form of a Veterinary Certificate to the Show Horse Committee on request.

From 1st July 2025, horses found competing with hair in the auricles removed or shortened within the rims of the auricle will be eliminated from the event. The auricle is the outer ear (the part that is visible). It is made of cartilage. It is covered with a thin layer of skin and muscles.

Who can eliminate a horse or issue a recorded warning? Officials recognised by EA are responsible for the implementation of all General Regulations and Rules, also to be read in conjunction with the National Show Horse Rules.

CLOSE OF ENTRIES

Entries close 9.00 PM Friday 5th April 2026. All fees must be paid at the time of entry via www.nominate.com.au.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fees will not be refunded after the close of entries.

In the event of a horse or rider being unfit to compete, a medical or vet certificate must be received by the office within 72 hours prior to the event and any refund will be at the discretion of the organising committee less an admin fee of \$25.00. There will be no further discussion after the decision has been made and given in writing. OFF THE TRACK RIDDEN THOROUGHBRED & STANDARDBRED

Off the Track classes are for retired racehorses & pacers.

ELIGIBILITY

Thoroughbreds must be registered with the Australian Studbook.
Standardbreds must be registered with Australian Harness Racing.

Unraced, untrilled and unnamed horses are all eligible to enter.

Horses do not need to be EA registered if they are only competing in these classes, however a minimal recreational membership is encouraged for insurance purposes.

Open to EA Members & Non-members, entries accepted by signing a waiver with entry.

Horses must be entered in their racing name and all horses must hold an Off the Track Passport Number that can be obtained at no charge from <https://www.offthetrackwa.com.au/off-the-track-wa-passport/>. A copy must be submitted with your entry to be accepted.

INDEMNITY

Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted, undertake to indemnify Equestrian WA, Riverside Riding Club, Off the Track, the OC, Officials & Sponsors against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse, and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity.

Riders are required to sign the declaration form included in the entry section. Neither Equestrian WA, Riverside Riding Club, Off the Track, nor the OC or their appointed officials accept any liability for any accident, theft or illness to horses, riders, grooms or any person or property whatsoever.

Important Notes:

- Article 116 of the EA General Regulations, which apply to this event, entitles the Organising Committee in its absolute and unfettered discretion to reject any entry, even after an entry has been accepted.
- This Competition Schedule is subject to change as Sponsorship Agreements are finalised.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to change the judges and/or alter the timetable.
