Bonds will be refunded the week following the event to all riders who provided a helper at or prior to the event. **SELF HELP** – limited positions available to riders riding one horse if requested via email events@equestrianwa.org.au prior to close of entries.

Horses need to be **EA registered** with a current **Eventing Competition Licence** to compete in CT95 and above. **CT80 and below** – minimum EA Adult Rider membership required to participate in these classes.

Substitutions: No substitution of horse or rider can be made after close of entries.
