General Business

Equestrian Western Australia

RoH provided a PowerPoint presentation on the EWA/ SEC financial position and provided forward cash flow projections.

The Board agreed:

- 1. That EWA will remain solvent until 30 June 2023.
- 2. DLGSC has been informed that we will be requiring the proposed Capital works grant \$370K and Arena grant \$485k be made available.
- 3. CEO to request a 12-month extension on the SEC lease from CoS
- 4. Inform insurer of fire services commitment.

Questions raised about EWA membership fees in comparison to other States. CEO said all States operate on different models and it is difficult to compare services provided

AD mentioned the possible bid by WA for the Special Olympics. AD to follow up re EWA inclusion.

Board portfolios review:

AD appointed to Audit and risk committee (A&R).

RF is considering if he will chair Welfare committee.

RH questioned the role of the A&R committee. RF responded - it is to identify risks and provide recommendations to the Board.

CEO recruitment update:

AW and RH met with the two preferred candidates. One has been selected and Lester Blade has performed four reference checks. The preferred CEO has verbally accepted EWA role. Contract is yet to be signed.

Governance Charter:

Agreed to accept Governance Charter. AD to review more fully and if needed, updates can be made in the future.

Life membership policy review:

PH was to present an update; deferred to next meeting.

Member survey actions:

New CEO and Comms officer can review actions to be taken. Survey to be circulated to Sport committees.

State Equestrian Centre

Update report from SEC committee re Concept Plan progress:

- RH reported SEC committee waiting for Dressage WA, Jumping WA and Perth Polocrosse to provide feedback and sign the letter of support.
- It was unanimously resolved to approve the payment of \$2,500 to TBB in payment of their fee to present the Concept Plan to the City of Swan with the aim of determining whether the City of Swan will support the initiative.

SEC Lease/Insurance and Fire services:

- 1. DLGSC has been informed that we will be requiring the proposed Capital works grant \$370K and Arena grant \$485k be made available.
