## CONDITION OF ENTRY

Conditions of Entries for the EWA Interschool Championships:

- **Clean Sport for Humans:** EA has been working closely with ASADA to introduce random drug testing at events throughout Australia. The link below contains current information regarding (human) athlete anti-doping in accordance with current ASADA/WADA rules. It is imperative that athletes, officials and coaches are familiar with the anti-doping policy and comply accordingly. <https://www.equestrian.org.au/content/clean-sport-humans>
- **Vaulting is an inclusive sport.** All vaulters with a disability are encouraged to compete in the class they feel most comfortable.
- **The Organising Committee** reserves the right to split classes that are oversubscribed. The draw for each split class will be determined through a random allocation of vaulters entered and horse welfare will be considered.
- **All competitors must meet the conditions** of entry set by the EWA interschool rules - 2026 Interschool State Championships Schedule ([equestrian.org.au](http://equestrian.org.au))

## AWARDS

Ribbons for first to sixth placings

Presentation of Awards:

- Presentation will take place at the competition's conclusion.
- A clean and smart school uniform from is required for all presentations, including the opening ceremonies. Plain black leggings and dark shoes are accepted with a school shirt. Hair must be presented neatly.

## VETERINARY NOTES

Swabbing

- Vaulters and Lungers refer to the current EA Australian Anti-Doping Policy.
- Horses refer to the current EA Equine Anti -Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations.

### EA Membership

- Lungers & Vaulters are required to hold current EA membership - Competitive VS Participant for all competitive classes.
- EA General Regs - Chapter I Equestrian Activity, Events and Competitions Article 100 - EA Activity Classification

### Competitor Numbers

Show Office: Open from 8am on Tuesday the 14th of April

- Vaulting Numbers: Vaulting numbers for individual competitors will be supplied. A fee for non-returned numbers at the close of competition will be issued.
- Bridle Numbers: Teams are to supply their own bridled numbers.
- All horses MUST wear bridle number whilst outside stables (RHS of halter & bridle)

### Refund Policy

- Withdrawal of entry prior to the close of entries will have a refund of entry fees less a \$50 administration fee.
- Refunds for scratching after the close of entries will have a 50% refund of entry fees less a \$50 administration fee. This must be accompanied by a veterinary or medical certificate (which must be received within 48hrs after the event).

# AT THE COMPETITION

## VOLUNTEERS

- It is expected that all vaulters will provide helpers to assist with setting up and dismantling the arena, pencilers, timekeepers, announcers, gear stewards, runners, etc.
- Provide names of volunteers/helpers on the entry form when it is completed as the competition is only as successful as the volunteers provided.

## CODE OF CONDUCT

- Vaulters and officials must observe the EA Code of Conduct
- Competition etiquette should be always observed.
- Officials, coaches, lungers and spectators to set their mobile phones to silent mode.
- All children must be under the supervision of an adult. If this person leaves the grounds, alternative supervision must be arranged.
- All clubs are responsible for ensuring that the property of Brookleigh Arena and other parties is respected and are liable for any damage caused.
- Competitors must comply with any instruction given by officials and/or organisers of the event.
- SEC Arena has a strict dog policy – dogs must be always on a lead and are not permitted in the warm up or indoor arena.
- Unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated from competitors or spectators, volunteers or officials

# VENUE CONDITIONS, ADDITIONAL FEES, CAMPING, STABLES & YARDS ETC.

## ADMINISTRATION FEE AND FACILITY FEE

Please note that a \$25 medical fee and a non-refundable \$50 administration fee apply to every rider. A compulsory State Equestrian Centre facility fee of \$15 per horse, per day also applies.

## STABLES

**Please ensure that you have ticked Yes or No to require a stable and completed other mandatory information. Upon close of entries stables will be allocated as per school and an invoice will be forwarded for payment. Stables must be paid prior to arrival.**

Stables will be available from **12:00pm on Tuesday 14 April 2026**. Stables are not available prior to this date. If you wish to arrive earlier, please use the polocrosse yards. You must only use the stable that has been allocated to you, failure to do will result in your bond being retained,

Stable allocation lists will be posted at the swab box.

Manure, hay and wet sawdust must be placed in the bunkers at the end of the stable blocks. For those competitors keeping their horses in the polocrosse yards, manure must be placed in the concrete bunkers provided.

Camping is available at the State Equestrian Centre free of charge for Equestrian WA Members.

There are a limited number of Powered sites these must be booked directly with the SEC .

Showers and toilets are available.

Power leads must not be on the ground or over roadways.

SEC Management considers it a privilege that you are allowed to bring your dog to this venue. We insist you keep your dog under effective control and on a leash at all times. **Dogs are not allowed in the indoor arena.**

Approved Safety Helmets must be worn at all times when riding.

Riding of horses bareback is prohibited.

Riding of rugged and/or unbridled horses is prohibited.

Horses are not permitted near pedestrian door ways.

## BICYCLES, SCOOTERS, MOTORISED BIKES

Except for special needs, by prior arrangement. Parents are responsible to ensure children ride in a safe manner and do not frighten horses or leave bicycles, etc on the ground where they may be a hazard to people or horses.

- Bicycles/scooters are not permitted in or around the Indoor Arenas and Competition areas or any stable block.
- Speed limits must be adhered to at all times, the speed limit at SEC is 10km p/h.
- Must be ridden with an helmet.
- Must only be ridden by one person at a time.

## NO BYO Alcohol

Please observe all signs at the venue.

Horses must be tied in a safe manner. Horses must not be tied to unattached floats, wheelie bins etc.

No infrastructure to be erected on SEC Grounds without written approval by management prior to event.

Entry and Exit doors to Indoors Arenas are not to be obstructed at any time.

Report any incidents, damages or safety concerns to SEC management immediately.
