#### **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Riders must be a current financial member of Western Dressage Association of Western Australia Inc. or pay a temporary day membership fee.
- 2. Waiver forms are to be completed for all entries.
- 3. Competition will be conducted in accordance with Western Dressage Association® of America rules (2014) and the Australian Addendum (2014). It is the competitor's responsibility to know the rules under which they compete. Rules and tests can be downloaded from the education tab of <a href="https://www.westerndressage.com.au">www.westerndressage.com.au</a>.
- 4. Horses may only compete at two consecutive levels for the event and in no more than three competitions.
- 5. Rider attire for this event is as per WDAA rules for all competitions.
- 6. Equipment must be in accordance with WDAA rules, i.e. western or stock with fenders.
- 7. All competition bridle wear and bits MUST be in accordance with the rules of WDAA. In particular NO drop, flash or grackle nosebands permitted. NO mechanical hackamores or twisted bits permitted. NO tie-downs or running reins permitted in warm-up or competition arenas.
- 8. Safety helmets are compulsory for all Youth riders at this event but are optional for senior riders in Level 1 or above
- No refunds after close of entries unless accompanied by a Doctors or Vet certificate within 7 days of completion of the event.
- 10. Draw will be available one week prior to the event and published on the web site <a href="www.westerndressage.com.au">www.westerndressage.com.au</a> and Cavaletti
- 11. The organising committee reserves the right to alter, amend or cancel any section of the program or to limit number of entries and/or ballot (on a first in basis) if nominations are excessive.
- 12. All riders are to abide by the conditions of entry, policies and procedures of Western Dressage Association of Western Australia Inc.
